#### Job summary

Four Elms Medical Centres would like to recruit an Advanced Clinical Practitioner for our innovative and sustainable practices; Four Elms Medical Centre based in Pengam Green, with a branch surgery in the CRI and Ringland Medical Practice based in Newport. We currently employ many advanced practitioners including a physicians associate, an advanced paramedic practitioner and an advanced nurse practitioner. The successful candidate will work alongside an established team of GPs and other allied health professionals. We also employ a mental health worker and a physiotherapy service. Travel between the Cardiff and Newport sites would be desirable but not compulsory.

Candidates can create a job that works for both them & us, as we aim to help people fit the job around their own lives. All forms of job share will be considered. If you would like to work with us you will find a supportive team who encourage innovative thinking, challenge the status quo and value personal development.

#### Main duties of the job

We are searching for an enthusiastic, hardworking, can-do individual. We want you to enjoy coming into work and to be fully engaged with us while we continue on our journey to introduce further innovation and to expand our business.

Because of our size and composition across two practices and two Health Boards there is always something for you to get involved in. It may be cluster work or chronic conditions or mentoring, really whatever you want to do which adds value to the practice will be considered.

## Job description

- Working with your own list of patients
- Conducting triage, assessing calling and visiting patients face-to-face and passing patients onto GPs, where appropriate for further consultation
- Care planning
- Creating relationships both internally and externally
- Reporting to the GP Partners and Practice Manager, as an advanced practitioner you will act within your professional boundaries, providing care for patients from initial history taking, clinical assessment, diagnosis, treatment and evaluation of their care under the supervision of a GP.
- You will show safe clinical decision-making and expert care for patients within the general practice, in consultation with the duty GP. You will work with the multidisciplinary general practice team to support the delivery of policy and procedures and meet the needs of patients.
- Supervision and mentoring will be provided by a GP Mentor.

You will have annual appraisals and continuing professional development as provided by your GP Mentor and any appropriate professional bodies.

We want your role to become a key part of our practice, working with the team to provide an enhanced care experience and continuously seeking improvements.

Whilst not essential, it would be beneficial to your application if you have worked in Primary care or if you have working knowledge of Emis Web.

This role will involve an element of travel between our three practice sites as and when required.
